Conference Outline

Day 1 - Tuesday, February 21

The goal of the first day is to present a variety of cases of developing technological entrepreneurship in universities – considering global, national and regional contexts. 20 minute presentations will cover the main features of the implemented models, will point out problems, solutions, and results. We ask the speakers to explore the rationale behind the models employed by their institutions.

Each presentation will be followed by a 10 minute discussion and 2-3 brief remarks from pre-selected analytical group. At the end of each session experts from the analytical group will give their summarizing remarks.

The closing session will be followed by a break and a reception.

Day 2 - Wednesday, February 22

The goal of the second day is to further explore the questions raised during Day 1.

Development of technological entrepreneurship requires involvement of various partners. Three of those will be presented and discussed at parallel sessions: business schools, research centers and industry.

Before and after parallel sessions we will have in-depth presentation of several cases. We ask the speakers to stress unique features of their models of developing innovative technological entrepreneurship.

At the conference representatives of Russian universities will have an opportunity to join the Association of Entrepreneurial Universities of Russia.
